

Chain Saw Safety









Overview

This program will provide students with the knowledge and skills required to safely operate a chain saw. This program is designed with the principles described in the Forest Professional handbook and, meets and exceeds the local regulations and industry standards.

Content

- Notching
- Limbing
- Maintenance

Format

The program is a combination of theory and practical training. Students are evaluated by means of a written test and a practical evaluation. Upon successful completion of the program, a certificate will be issued.

Duration

½ day bucking only, 1 day and two day programs also available

Location

Training is delivered at the Hercules Training Academy or can also be delivered on-site.

Required PPE

CSA approved safety boots (chain saw cut resistant required in NB), safety glasses, hard hat (with visor), hearing protection, Chain saw cut resistant pants or chaps
